When the Olympics schedule was released, he was shocked. The 100-meter event was scheduled for Sunday. In spite of incredible pressure put upon him by the British press, Eric refused to compete. He switched to the 400-meter race, he had never run in his life.

Just before the race, an American runner, Jackson Scholz, handed Liddle a note. It contained this sentence from John 12:26: “My father will honor anyone who serves me.”

Seconds later, Eric won the 400-meter event. Still clutched in his hand was the note Jackson Scholz had given him.
